


New products continue to feature in the smart home market





- Lenovo India has announced the launch of new smart home devices to expand its IoT and smart home portfolio in India
- > The new launches include a smart display, smart bulb, and smart camera, which can be controlled by Google Assistant support



- Resideo Technologies launched its Resideo Home app for whole-home monitoring including the four critical networks of water, air, energy and security
- > The app will allow the homeowners to easily connect with professionals who can help ensure home networks are operating efficiently and can intervene to help prevent costly damages, like water leaks and major appliance failures.





Funding support to Level Home's innovative smart lock by retailer Walmart is an indication of them stepping up their competition with the online retail giant Amazon. Notably, Amazon had launched Amazon Key back in October 2017 for convenient home delivery of parcels.

Start-ups secure funding for business expansion



- Level Home secured \$71M from Walmart for its innovative smart lock that enables remote access. and sharing of access to homes
- The Level Home smart lock will allow home delivery of groceries without compromising on security even when user is not at home



- Smart apartment startup IOTAS has received \$8.5 million of funding from Intel. TELUS Ventures and Liberty Global
- The startup has raised \$17 million till the date
- > The company has contracts to supply technology for 10,000 apartments altogether

- Shine Bathroom, a smart home startup from Santa Barbar has raised \$750,000 in seed funding to help build and distribute its first product
- > The funding has come from Entrada Ventures and Mucker Capital



Israeli provider of radar imaging sensor technology, Vayyar Imaging Ltd., secured \$109 million in its latest financing round led by Koch Disruptive Technologies and also joined by existing investors including Battery Ventures, Bessemer Ventures, ICV, ITI, WRVI Capital and Claltech.






