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
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Tesla secures large Megapack project to replace gas peak plant





Highview Power is on a fast-track to develop cryogenic energy storage systems around the globe. The company has already initiated development of multiple projects in Europe and US. It received £35 million investment from Sumitomo Heavy Industries in February 2020. A part of this investment will be utilized for the development of the project at Trafford Energy Park.

Highview Power awarded 10 million Pound grant from UK Government for world's biggest liquid air battery



 Highview Power has announced that it has been awarded a 10 million Pound grant from the UK Department for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy (BEIS) for a 50 MW cryogenic energy storage facility at Trafford Energy Park, outside of Manchester.

The project will be developed jointly with independent power station developer Carlton Power. CRYOBattery offers a competitive levelized cost of storage at approximately Pound 110/MWh for a 10-hour, 200 MW / 2 GWh system for large-scale applications.

Community energy utilities in California issue Request for Information on long duration energy storage technologies



 A group of 11 community-focused energy utilities in California have issued a Request for Information on long duration energy storage technologies.

The technologies are expected to be able to discharge at full capacity for minimum eight hours and should be able to interconnect directly to transmission or distribution networks and can participate in CAISO electricity markets. The project marks its importance as it is the first private sector initiative in Thailand to integrate utility-scale wind power generation with a battery energy storage system.

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Under the deal, Stem's Athena™ AI platform will provide the intelligence and real-time decision making to optimize the storage system and energy use for the new portfolio customers and provide local controllable capacity to SCE. The platform will enable Stem to seamlessly onboard 87 complex systems and bring new revenue streams to the customers and asset owners.

# Stem awarded exclusive deal to deliver intelligent Energy Storage Management

## stem

 Stem, an artificial intelligence- driven energy storage services company, is awarded a contract to provide its advanced, intelligent software for managing a portfolio of storage assets owned in partnership by SK E&S and SUSI Partners.

The portfolio consists of 345 MWh and 25 new commercial and municipal Southern California Edison (SCE) customers in the Los Angeles area. With the expandable capacity of 400MW, the project will have initial capacity of 75MW. Financial details of the investment have not been disclosed. The project will supply clean energy and ancillary services to Alberta Electricity Grid.

EDF Renewables has displayed multiple activities in the month. Along with signing the optimization agreement with Zenobe, EDF Renewables UK partnered with Octo Energy to find new hybrid solar and battery projects of total capacity 200 MW in England and Wales. # Tesla secures large Megapack project to replace gas peak plant



 Tesla has secured a massive Megapack project that is being deployed to replace to-beconstructed gas peak plant in California. Southern California Edison has rejected the proposal of construction of a new gas-fired power plant has pivoted to energy storage instead.

Southern California Edison plans to deploy several battery systems, while the biggest one of capacity 100 MW/400 MWh will be developed by Strata Solar. Though Strata Solar builds its own battery systems, interestingly, it has announced that it has now selected the Tesla Megapack for the new project with Southern California Edison.

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# EDF and Zenobe partner over battery trading





EDF and Zenobe Energy have partnered to jointly trade and optimize 59MW of grid scale battery portfolio. The partnership will extend Zenobe's access to the wholesale market and balancing mechanism by utilizing EDF's trading expertise. The deal also includes contracts for supply and off take of energy.

The two companies will work together on maximizing return on investments. Zenobe will work collaboratively with EDF to select asset trading strategies. Under the deal, EDF will provide Zenobe with a floor price ensuring minimum income levels are protected.

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The Aratina Solar Center alone is expected to generate hundreds of millions in total capital investment, more than \$12 million in local tax revenues, \$16 million in land payments over the life of the project and 300 direct construction jobs.

8minute Solar Energy Signs Contract with MBCP and SVCE for Development of 250 MW Solar-Plus-Storage Project



 8minute Solar Energy has executed a power purchase agreement (PPA) with Monterey Bay Community Power Authority (MBCP) and Silicon Valley Clean Energy (SVCE). This is 8minute's first project with Community Choice Energy providers.

The Aratina Solar Center is being built in Kern County, California and is scheduled to come online before the end of 2023. The project capacity is 250-megawatt (250 MWdc / 200 MWac) which includes 150 MWh of energy storage. Aratina Solar Center will provide enough power for 93,000 homes.

8minute Solar Energy Secures \$225 Million Letter of Credit Facility for Solar and Energy Storage Projects



8minute Solar Energy has closed a \$225 million letter of credit (LC) facility from a consortium of five banks: CIT, KeyBank N.A., HSBC, Rabobank and Nomura. The part of credit facility will be used for 18-gigawatt (GW) pipeline of solar and storage projects throughout California, Texas and the Southwestern United States.

The projects include more than 50 utility-scale projects in various stages of development, with a typical project size of 400 MW. 8minute's new generation solar plant design with integrated energy storage will be deployed in most of these projects.
